



## CENTRALIA CARES COVID-19 COMMUNITY PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The City of Centralia is accepting proposals from non-profit organizations which are developed in direct response to the public health emergency from the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), and which will directly assist businesses and individuals impacted by COVID-19 or the response to COVID-19 as outlined in the CARES ACT as signed by the President of the United States.

Program proposals must focus on businesses and individuals that reside or are located in the City of Centralia (within the city limits) and either facilitate compliance with COVID-19 public health measures or provide economic support in connection with the COVID-19 public health emergency. Proposals may include?

- Financial Assistance to Small Business impacted by the response to COVID19 closures.
- Financial Assistance to provide funding for childcare for public health and public safety workers responding to COVID 19.
- Financial assistance for the continued delivery of food to seniors.
- Financial assistance for expansion of shelter access for people impacted by COVID19.

The minimum program proposal accepted is \$50,000.

Awardee understands these funds are pass-through federal funds and use of these funds is subject to Federal Audit Requirements. Awardee must be able to report and comply with requirements of OMB Super Circular 2 CRF 200.501 to the City of Centralia.

Awardee must certify that the expenditures submitted to the city are in compliance with the US Treasury Coronavirus Relief Fund Guidance for State, Territorial, Local and Tribal Governments.
