Centralia, WA. A 32 year old male from Centralia dies from an accidental overdose.

On October 23, 2020 Centralia Police responded to the scene of a male who was unconscious and not breathing. The male was pronounced deceased prior to being transported to the hospital. A preliminary investigation revealed the male was attempting to text his girlfriend for help prior to succumbing to the effects of the illegal narcotics. The male ingested what he thought was Percocet, but was actually counterfeit pills that have the appearance of being the prescription drug Oxycodone. The pills were blue in color and were branded with the impression "M 30" and suspected to contain Fentanyl.

Members of the Joint Narcotics Enforcement Team (JNET), and the Centralia Police Department immediately opened an investigation with the assistance of the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA). Investigators were able to quickly identify two subjects who had directly distributed small round pills branded with the impressions "M 30" to the deceased. An additional four narcotics dealers were identified by investigators as the ones providing the illegal narcotics that led to the death of the 32 year old male. Thus far a total of six people have been arrested in connection with this investigation.

Alexandria Delaney, 24 of Centralia and a 17 year old male of Centralia have been arrested for Controlled Substance Homicide. Marcus Inman, 31 of Centralia, Felecia Segerman, 23 of Centralia, Larencia Moore, 18 of Centralia and a 16 year old female from Napavine have been arrested for Delivery of a Controlled Substance.
