FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Updated Flood Warning in Centralia, WA

Due to the low river levels, the flood does not require a continuation of the Emergency Operations Center to be open in Centralia after 5pm on Wednesday, December 09, 2015. The following streets will remain closed until further notice:

N. Rock Street from Main Street to Magnolia Street

N. Iron Street from Main Street to Magnolia Street

Intersection of Oak Street at Maple Street

Kresky Avenue at Scott Johnson Road (traffic is being diverted at Hampe Way)

Delaware Avenue

Roswell Road

There is still standing water over the roadway in many places. The water is slow to drain. Please remember to use caution and drive slow, as the roads have not been inspected for damage.

The two sandbag stations will remain open in the 400 block of N. Pearl Street (parking lot on the NW corner of Pearl Street and Maple Street) and the City Maintenance Shop at 2600 Reynolds Road.

The rivers and creeks are still being monitored.
