

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
USE OF SMALL WORKS ROSTER  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF CENTRALIA AND TWIN TRANSIT**

THIS AGREEMENT IS MADE by and between the City of Centralia, a municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "City") and Twin Transit, a local public transit system, authorizing the use of the Small Works Roster maintained by the City, pursuant to RCW 39.04.155 and RCW 39.04.190 respectively.

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, contemplates that municipal corporations in Washington may agree to allow the use of public bid documents previously used by a municipal corporation, as long as there is an agreement in place authorizing such use; and

WHEREAS, such authority also enables one agency to utilize the Small Works Roster of another agency, as long as there is an agreement in place authorizing such use; and

WHEREAS, the City already maintains and administers a Small Works Roster pursuant to statutes and is willing to allow other governmental agencies to use such bid documents if they are party to an interlocal agreement and pay any added costs that their use might impose on the City;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Authority. This agreement is entered into pursuant to the authority of RCW 39.34.
2. Purpose of Agreement. The purpose of this agreement is to allow Twin Transit to use the Small Works Roster maintained by the City, without any additional or extraneous cost to City.
3. Approval. The City hereby approves such use of the Small Works Roster by Twin Transit, subject to such user following all rules and procedures applicable to such use and subject to payment of any added costs.
4. Duration. This Agreement shall remain in effect until the COVID-19 State and local emergency declarations are no longer in effect.
