The Centralia Municipal Court will be resuming in person hearings starting June 2, 2020. Safety precautions have been put in place for the safety of our Visitors and City Employees.

You will be required to give your name to confirm you have a court hearing in order to enter the building. Hand sanitizer will be provided upon entry. If you have not brought your own mask, one will be provided. Directions regarding face coverings will be given to individuals when necessary. If you are unable to wear a mask, you must provide a doctor's note. Courtroom seating will be extremely limited for social distancing. Do not bring people with you to court.

If you are unable to appear in court due to illness, please contact your attorney to make other arrangements or call 360-330-7667 to speak with a court clerk.

Please be sure to contact your attorney prior to your hearing. In order to keep court running as smoothly as possible, meetings with your attorney should occur prior to your court date and outside of City Hall.
