CMC Section 15.10.350 Schedule of charges.

B. Capital Facility Charge.

1. So that the property owners shall bear their equitable share of the cost of the wastewater system and as authorized in RCW 35.92.035, there shall be paid a capital facilities charge at the time the application is approved for a wastewater connection based on the size of the water meter (see exception in CMC 15.10.100 for certain

When a request or requirement for a larger size water meter is made, the additional capital facilities charge for wastewater will be the difference between the old water meter size and the new water meter size based on the current schedule of capital

The capital facility charges shall be as follows:

*On January 1st of each year beginning in 2012, capital facility charges shall be adjusted to reflect the annual percentage increase of the **Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index (ENR CCI)** as published for November of the preceding year. Calculation of the change in the index is made by dividing the current index for November by the preceding index for November and subtracting one.*
