



HARRISON AVE HIGH STREET TO MAIN STREET ASPHALT PAVING

OVERVIEW

The City of Centralia will be completing improvements to Harrison Avenue between High Street and Main Street this summer. The existing roadway surface is deteriorating and needs to be repaved before it deteriorates further. Currently, there are no bicycle lanes on Harrison Avenue between First Street and Main Street and the existing concrete median curbing needs to be replaced to ensure the safety of the traveling public.

Work on this project will include grinding the existing asphalt on Harrison Avenue and repaving, pavement repair at the intersecting streets and repaving the approaches, concrete curbing removal, concrete curbing and median installation, new bicycle lane striping between First Street and Main Street and roadway striping and sign installation for the entire corridor.

In preparation for these improvements, in 2022 the City upgraded the signals at the High Street and Bridge Street intersections and made safety improvements between Bridge Street and First Street. Substandard sidewalk ADA ramps and pedestrian push buttons at the existing signalized intersections were updated as well.

SCHEDULE

The project was awarded to Lakeside Industries on June 14, 2023. Construction will begin August 7, 2023 and be completed by the end of September. Most of the work within the traveled roadway for this asphalt paving project will take place at night to limit the impacts on this arterial roadway.

FUNDING

The total estimated cost of this project is \$1.5 Million. This project is federally funded with a 13.5% local match requirement. The City's matching funds are being paid for through the Transportation Benefit Fund.
