Ball Park Regulations

- No dogs or other pets allowed.
- Alcohol prohibited—Ord. #1347
- Smoking prohibited in complexes, stadium, other ballfield areas and on school district property.
- No sunflower seeds or nuts in the shell allowed in complexes or Wheeler stadium.
- Fields 6, 7, 8, 9 must meet RCW 28A.210.310, RCW 69.50.435, and RCW 9.41.280 pertaining to tobacco, drugs, and weapons on school district property.
- No hardball on Fields 2, 3, 4 unless approved by the Parks and Recreation Department
- Unauthorized vehicles prohibited.
- Keep off prepped fields unless officially scheduled to use.
- Keep off fields when posted or when field is visibly unplayable.
- No hitting or pitching balls of any kind into fences.
- Fence climbing prohibited.
- No littering—please use trash receptacles.
- No bike riding, skateboarding, rollerblading, or scooters allowed in complex.
- No food or beverages on playing surfaces or fields
- No advertising, marketing, selling or soliciting allowed without prior approval by authorizing entity (city of Centralia or Centralia Little League).
- Overnight parking or camping is prohibited in Borst Park—no exceptions.
- Daytime parking for RVs and oversized vehicles in designated areas only.

Ball Park Code of Conduct

For the safety and health of all involved in a sporting event at a City of Centralia and or Centralia School District ballfield, whether actively or passively participating, unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action or ejection from the fields or facilities. City of Centralia, Centralia School District and/or Centralia Little League representatives have the right to ask anyone to leave the park if behavior, actions, language or clothing is deemed unacceptable. Inappropriate behavior includes but is not limited to:

- Physically or verbally threatening the well-being of an umpire, competitor, spectator, City or School District employee or league board member or representative
- Addressing an umpire, competitor, spectator, City or School District employee or league board member or representative in a disrespectful manner
- Fighting and/or aggressive behavior
- Use of vulgar language
- Endangering actions (e.g. throwing equipment)
- Inappropriate gestures
- Intoxication
- Vandalism
