

RESOLUTION NO. 2814

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CENTRALIA, WASHINGTON AMENDING THE 2025-2030 SIX-YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2024, the City of Centralia (“City”) adopted Resolution 2805 to revise and extend its six-year comprehensive transportation program pursuant to Chapter 35.77 of the Revised Code of Washington (“RCW”);

WHEREAS, RCW 35.77.010 grants the City Council the authority to revise its transportation program at any time after holding a public hearing on the proposed revisions; and

WHEREAS, after duly publishing notice, the City Council held a public hearing on January 14, 2025 to hear and consider public comments on proposed amendments to the 2025-2030 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRALIA, WASHINGTON:

Section 1. That the amendments to the 2025-2030 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program as presented to the City Council on January 14, 2025 are hereby approved and adopted

Section 2. That the amended 2025-2030 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program shall be forwarded to the Secretary of Transportation within thirty days after its adoption.
