

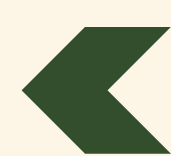
MAIN STREET CORRIDOR

How can Main Street be improved for the benefit of the public and to spur economic development?



Improvements in the corridor will require both public and private investment. Public investment depends on grant funding. A good plan backed by the public will help the city be more competitive for grants.

What's Happening?



The City of Centralia won a Thriving Communities Grant that provides technical assistance to advance our Hub City Greenways vision. Main Street is the spine of the HCG trail system.



In 2025-2026 the City will be engaging the public to develop a plan for Main Street, including streetscape improvements, a visual gateway to Centralia College and other strategies and actions.



As part of the process the grant will also pay for a market study to better understand the commercial and real estate development opportunities in the corridor.
