



2015 Lewis County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan Update

Thank you for your interest in participating in the 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan Update. In 2010, we had nine cities and forty other agencies participate in the LC Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. By participating and adopting the Plan these agencies are eligible to apply for and/or receive project grants under the following hazard mitigation assistance programs:

- Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)
- Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM)
- Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA)
- Severe Repetitive Loss (SRL)

To continue eligibility, the plan must be reviewed, revised, and resubmitted within five years of the original approval date. To assist you in that effort, we are scheduling public meetings; created a website and an on-line Hazard/Preparedness survey – data to be made available to all jurisdictions; holding Open Houses in June and July with a goal to adopt the revised plan by all Stakeholders in August and September.

At the meetings scheduled in April and May, you will be provided with a copy of all information submitted five years ago, as well as new Capability Assessment Worksheets that must be completed as part of the renewal process. If you are unable to attend one of the four meetings, a copy of the information will be sent to you.
